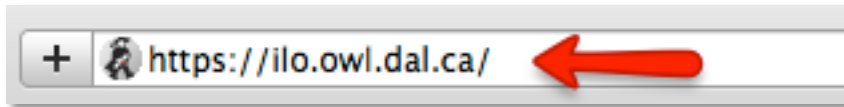


## OWL QUICKSTART GUIDE


In order to access the files you need for your tutorial or clinical sessions with students, you will need to log-on to OWL, Dalhousie's learning management system.

1. Navigate to <https://ilo.owl.dal.ca> in your web browser.



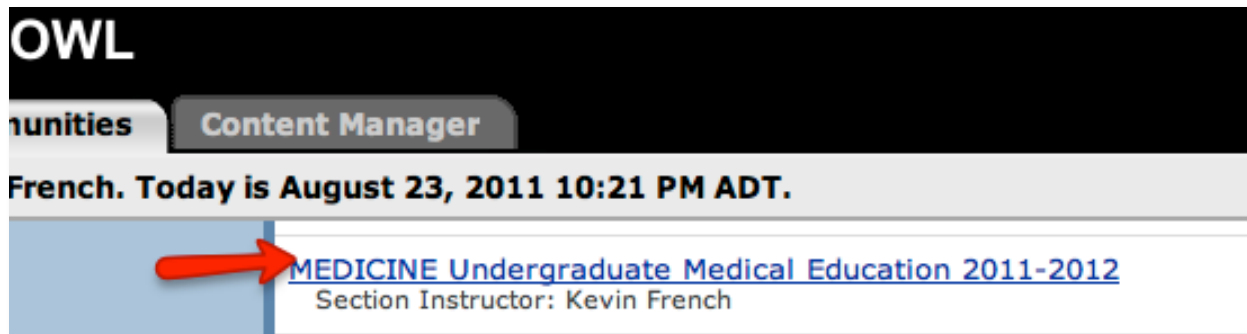
2. To login, enter your NetID and password in the appropriate boxes. Click OK.

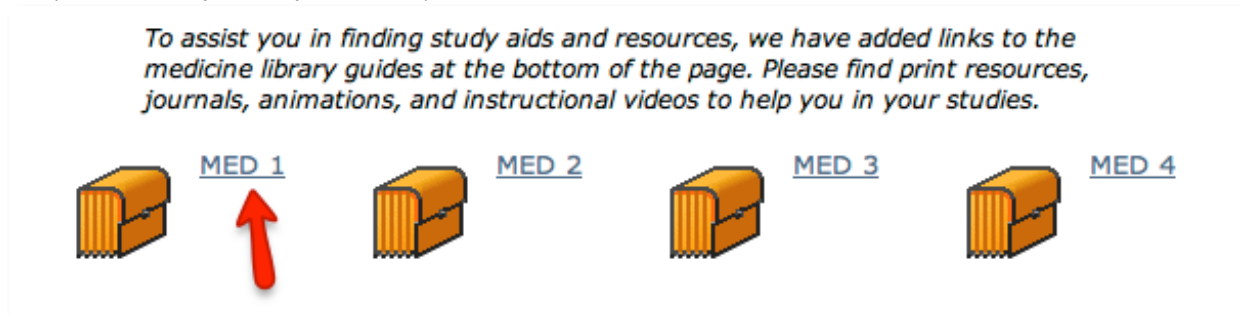
